

Students with fee debt from 2022 who were on UCT financial aid or GAP funding



Students on GAP funding in 2022, who failed to meet the academic requirements for renewal, can submit an appeal to the Student Financial Aid Office provided they are within the N+2 rule and have made sufficient academic progress to complete their programme of study or are finalists for 2023 within N+3.



While NSFAS does not consider the N+3 funding appeals, UCT may consider such appeals in exceptional circumstances for students in their final year of study who have a course or two to complete.



The UCT funding for approved students who meet the policy criteria (who exceed the N+ rule) will be a UCT student loan and top up bursary funding subject to approved cost of study.
