- Be a male student returning to UCT in 2025 and 2026

- Be able to commit to creating a minimum of eight posts per year on request from the OIC
- Be able to commit to facilitating a minimum of four online engagements (per year?)
- Own or have access to a smart phone
- Have line manager's approval (in case of staff members)
