## UCT to graduate 89 doctoral candidates this month 5249 total graduands to be hooded between 12 and 17 December 2011

The University of Cape Town will graduate a total of 89 Doctors of Philosophy at 12 ceremonies beginning at 10h00 on Monday, 12 December 2011. The total number of graduates for December 2011 is 5249, an increase of 187 graduates from December 2010. The total number of PhDs awarded for 2011, including the June graduates, is 152.

The faculty breakdown for December 2011 PhD graduates is: 7 for Commerce; 10 for Engineering & Built Environment; 24 for Health Sciences; 15 for Humanities; 6 for Law; and 27 for Science.

UCT will present Archbishop Emeritus Desmond Tutu with the Graça Machel Chancellor's Award for Continental Leadership at 10h00 on Monday, 12 December, during the first graduation ceremony for the Faculty of Health Science. He will be the second person to receive this award, after President Thabo Mbeki received the Chancellor's Award for Outstanding Leadership in Africa in 2004.

Also on Monday 12 December, at the Faculty of Humanities graduation ceremony at 15h00, UCT alumna and human rights activist Mary Burton will be awarded an honorary doctorate in Social Science for her enduring commitment to justice and reconciliation, and the leading role she has played in bodies esteemed for their advancement of liberty.

On Tuesday, 13 December, at 15h00, inventor, entrepreneur and a philanthropist Dr David Potter will receive an honorary doctorate in Engineering Science. In 1980, he founded the software company Psion, which later introduced the world's first handheld computer and the term "netbook" to the industry.

UCT will also bestow two Social Responsiveness Awards, four Distinguished Teacher Awards, four new Fellowships and a President of Convocation Medal to academic staff. Associate Professor Ralph Hamann, the Research Director at UCT's Graduate School of Business, and Dr Dee Smythe, Director of the Law, Race and Gender

Research Unit in the Faculty of Law, will each receive the 2011 Social Responsiveness Award on behalf of their respective units. The award was established in 2009 by Vice-Chancellor Dr Max Price, to promote the university's commitment to social responsiveness as an important institutional activity. It is awarded to staff whose activities benefit not only UCT but also an external community.

The Distinguished Teacher Award is the highest accolade given to teaching staff at all levels within the university, in recognition of excellent teaching. Through the award UCT acknowledges the primary place of teaching and learning in the university's work. This year the award will be given to: Dr Susan Levine (Senior lecturer, Department of Social Anthropology), Timothy Low (Lecturer, Department of Statistical Sciences), Dr Gregory Smith (Lecturer, Department of Chemistry) and Associate Professor Mike Campbell (Head of Jazz Studies, South African College of Music).

There are more than 25 352 students registered at UCT this year, in undergraduate and postgraduate programmes. In 2010, the university graduated a total of 6355 students, including 167 doctoral candidates.
