Sirkusboere tells the story of a group of traumatised, maimed and penniless veterans of the South African War (1899 – 1902) who were recruited by legendary circus owner Frank Fillis to participate in a bizarre military spectacle at the 1904 World's Fair in St. Louis, Missouri. The meticulously researched *Sirkusboere* is a story about trauma, diaspora, showbiz, freakery, racial discrimination, loss, displacement, rollercoasters and sport.

J.M. Coetzee: Countervoices pays sustained attention to the dynamic interaction between Coetzee's fiction and his critical writing, exploring the Nobel Prize winner's participation in and contribution to contemporary literary-philosophical debates.

Raw Life, New Hope takes a close look at the lives of the residents of The Park, a township on the outskirts of Cape Town. Ross has tried to capture the little details of life in the community that illustrate how people create meaning in their lives.
