UCT admission deadline looms

Financial assistance applications deadline: 31 October 2015

The deadline for admission for the 2016 academic year at the University of Cape Town (UCT) is 30 September for all undergraduate programmes. No late applications will be accepted. Those who want to apply for admission need not wait for their end-of-year results because UCT takes all school results from Grade 11 final results through to Grade 12, including all term results. Undergraduate and postgraduate application fees from South Africa and the Southern African Development Countries (SADC) region are R100, while undergraduate and postgraduate application fees from outside the SADC region cost R300.

Carl Herman, Director of Admissions at UCT, says the choice of study programme is very important. "We advise senior learners in Grades 11 and 12 to do as much research as possible into the programmes available and how they are suited to these programmes ahead of being admitted or in applying for admission; that's a very key step," says Herman.

The criteria for admission to Postgraduate Diplomas and Honours, Master's and Doctoral degrees vary from one programme to another. Prospective applicants are advised to consult the Faculty concerned directly, in order to determine the requirements for admission. Financial assistance applications due on 31 October

UCT is committed to doing all it can to help financially needy students pursue their academic goals and ultimately contribute to the growth of the economy. have passed at least half of their courses in the previous year to be eligible for financial aid.
