Media Invite: UCT to host panel discussion on mental health in South Africa

The University of Cape Town's Alan J Flisher Centre for Public Mental Health (CPMH) will host a panel discussion on mental health in South Africa titled "Economy, Equality & Access to Mental Health Services".

The panel discussion intends to share expertise and experience on the political, economic, occupational and sociological aspects of caring for the mental health of South Africa.

Leading researchers from UCT, Stellenbosch University and the University of Manchester are scheduled to speak at the event. Highlights and key issues to be addressed include food insecurity and mental-ill health, mental health in the workplace, deinstitutionalisation as well as the link between poverty, equality and mental illness.

This panel discussion takes place at the beginning of World Mental Health Month and serves to commemorate World Mental Health Day the following week (10 October). World Mental Health Day is a day for global mental health education, awareness and advocacy against social stigma. This year's theme, set by the World Federation for Mental Health, is "Mental Health in the Workplace".
