## UCT announces senior appointments

The University of Cape Town has announced a number of appointments at senior leadership level.

These include the appointment of Professor Lis Lange as the Deputy Vice-Chancellor: Teaching and Learning, with effect from 1 February 2018.

Professor Lange is currently the Vice-Rector: Academic at the University of the Free State. She will take over from Professor Daya Reddy, who has been serving as acting DVC since January 2017 and has had his term of office extended by a month to 31 January 2018.

The contract of acting DVC: Institutional Innovation, Professor Hugh Corder, has been extended until 31 January 2017. Thereafter, Professor Andre le Roex will assume the role in an acting capacity from 1 February 2018.

Professor Le Roex is scheduled to conclude his seven-year tenure as Dean of Science at the end of December 2017. He will be succeeded by Professor Susan Bourne, who will act in the role from 1 January 2018 until 30 June 2019.

In the Faculty of Humanities, Professor David Wardle has been appointed as the acting Dean with effect from 7 December until 31 December 2018.
