UCT makes key senior leadership appointments

The University of Cape Town (UCT) has announced the appointment of Professor Elelwani Ramugondo as Deputy Vice-Chancellor (DVC) for Transformation, Student Affairs and Social Responsiveness and Professor Suki Goodman as Dean of Commerce.

Professor Ramugondo will start her tenure on 1 July 2022. Presently the deputy dean for postgraduate education in the Faculty of Health Sciences, Professor Ramugondo has over 20 years of academic experience in a research-intensive university environment. She served as special advisor on transformation to the Vice-Chancellor in 2015.

The current head of the School of Management Studies, Professor Goodman, will assume her new role with effect from 1 January 2022. Prior to assuming the role as head of the School, she headed the section of Organisational Psychology. Both roles have prepared her with extensive leadership and management experience.

UCT also recently appointed Vincent Motholo as Executive Director: Finance – the first black African to occupy this role at the university. Motholo, a qualified chartered accountant, registered auditor and current chairperson of the South African Institute of Chartered Accountants (SAICA), joined UCT on 1 October 2021.

UCT Chair of Council, Babalwa Ngonyama noted that since Professor Mamokgethi Phakeng took office in 2018, a total of 13 senior leadership appointments were made and 11 of these were from the designated groups.
