Zuptas, Bain, global complicity and Zondo

The University of Cape Town's (UCT) Summer School will host a public lecture by renowned exiled former anti-apartheid leader and United Kingdom cabinet minister, Lord Peter Hain, on Saturday 11 March 2023 at Lecture Theatre 1, Kramer Law Building, UCT middle campus.

Lord Hain will talk about 50 years of campaigning against apartheid and corruption and building a new future. He will discuss his role in exposing global complicity in state capture, the inside story of his campaigning and why it matters to him and the future of South Africa.

The child of South African parents, Lord Hain was jailed, banned, and forced into exile during the freedom struggle, Peter Hain led anti-apartheid campaigns to stop all-white South African sports tours. He served in the United Kingdom Labour Government for twelve years, seven of these in the cabinet.

He negotiated the 2007 settlement to end the conflict in Northern Ireland and was a Foreign Minister with successive responsibilities for Africa, the Middle East and Europe. He has chaired the United Nations Security Council and negotiated international treaties. He was also Secretary of State for Work and Pensions, Secretary of State for Wales, leader of the House of Commons and Energy Minister.
