PROPOSED CONSERVATION FRAMEWORK, HERITAGE
AGREEMENT AND INVENTORY FOR SIX CAMPUSES OF
THE UNIVERSITY OF CAPE TOWN
(Heritage Western Cape Ref. 21090806)

Notice is hereby given that a draft Conservation Framework, Heritage Agreement and Inventory compiled to meet the requirements of Sections 42 and 30 of the National Heritage Resources Act are to be submitted in due course to Heritage Western Cape (HWC) for decisions under those provisions so as to provide for greater clarity in decision-making regarding development on the six University's campuses generally. The six campuses are those known as the Hiddingh Campus in the Gardens, the Upper or Main Campus in Rondebosch, the Middle and Lower Campus in Rondebosch, the Middle and Lower Campus in Rosebank, the Residential Precinct in Mowbray, and the Health Sciences Campus in Observatory

This process is undertaken in conjunction with a land-use planning process (a package of plans including a development framework and precinct plans informed by these heritage studies), which is being advertised concurrently with this Conservation Framework, Heritage Agreement and Inventory.
