THE FINAL PUSH: IRTC finalizes its report and calls for last submissions by September 30th

The Institutional Reconciliation & Transformation Commission (IRTC) thanks the broader UCT community for its involvement in the Commission's processes so far. As the Commission finalizels its report, it also hopes for more students and PASS staff especially to make submissions.

The absolute final deadline has been set to September 30th with the following themes as stipulated in the last 2 of the 6 Steering Committee's (SC) Terms of references (TORs) being paramount in this second part of the IRTC's work:-

5. "Invite all constituencies - and be able to

request relevant individuals and structures, including task teams – to make submissions on institutional culture and practices, including decolonisation and any that entail unjust discrimination, domination or violence, including sexual violence."

6. "Make recommendations on institutional culture, transformation, decolonisation, discrimination, identity, disability, labour relations and any other matters that the university community has raised over the years, or may wish to raise."

Having dealt with clemency and amnesty issues, the Commissioners are seeking input from the broader UCT community on the second Reconciliation phase in their bid to foster Reconciliation and forge a path for Transformation at the university.

The absolute final deadline is 30 September

2018.
