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UCT to swiftly intervene in workers issues

The University of Cape Town executive is working on swiftly dealing with issues raised through a picket by catering staff workers on Friday morning.

The picket is taking place on Lower Campus and involves approximately 250 catering staff members. This has affected five residences, where breakfast was not served on Friday morning. Meal vouchers have been issued to students at these residences for breakfast and lunch.

The picketing group had not raised any issues through the available formal channels at the university prior to embarking on this action. The executive is engaging with the group to establish what the issues are and how these can be resolved.

The UCT executive is committed to engaging with the staff members in order to ensure that any issues are resolved amicably, and catering services to resume as speedily as possible.
