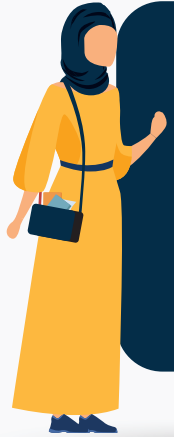


Academic Appeals for UCT funded students



Students on UCT financial aid or GAP funding in 2021, who failed to pass at least 50% of their courses, and are therefore not eligible for funding in 2022, must please appeal to the Student Financial Aid Office.



What you need to do: Submit an online appeal by logging onto your PeopleSoft Student Portal. This function is only available to NSFAS, financial aid and GAP-funded students who did not meet the minimum academic progression requirements.



Pre-2018 students who are within N+3 years of funding and who are 2022 finalists (those who will graduate if they pass all their courses in 2022) will continue to receive UCT-financed aid or GAP funding, as per normal funding rules.



N+3 students will automatically be processed by the Student Financial Aid Office and need not submit any appeal, provided the information is available that the student will be a potential finalist in 2022.



Due to budget availability and to ensure fairness of access to resources, appeals will not be considered for N+4 funding.



The funding for students that exceed the N+ rule will be a UCT Student Loan and top up bursary funding subject to approved cost of study.
