



# The Vice-Chancellor's Blue Carpet Scholarship

- The scholarship is awarded to matriculants who have excelled in the final National Senior Certificate (NSC) examinations and want to study at the University of Cape Town.
- It is valued at R100 000 per year, and is valid for up to three years subject to the student being named on their faculty's Dean's Merit List.
- It covers charges relating to tuition and residence only.
- The balance of funds, if applicable, can be used for laptops, books or other study needs.
- It replaces entrance scholarship, should you have any, however, it may be held concurrently with an external award, or financial aid.
- It is awarded at a pro-rated value for students qualifying for staff tuition rate.
- It is renewable based on being awarded the Dean's Merit as per each faculty's specifications.

## Terms and Conditions

- The applicant must have passed Independent Examination Board (IEB) and NSC examination in 2022 and you are among the top five 2023 UCT applicants in this category.
- The applicants must be in the top 10 achievers in Mathematics, English or Computer Science Olympiad in 2022.
- Among Top 10 in Western Cape Education Department schools and or top 15 in Department of Basic Education.

The Vice-Chancellor's awardees will, in most cases, receive correspondence in January 2023 after the NSC results have been released.
